5 Tips for your Next Networking Event

One of the perks of being a Chamber member is all the networking opportunities we provide. Our Board of Directors works diligently to organize a variety of activities ranging from after-hours events and membership meetings to annual & powerful events like the Golf Outing, Rose Parade, Taste of Roselle and more. We plan and help organize the details locations, setting, topics, food - and pave the way for YOU to meet other businesses and connect with them.

While a room full of business leaders might seem intimidating, it offers a limitless number of potentially prosperous interactions. It is an investment in your business and can yield great results for years to come.

Today, we will share several tips to get you in the right mindset for the next networking event you plan to attend. You have probably heard enough about practicing your elevator speech and giving out your business card so we will skip the obvious and dig right in to other pointers.

- 1. While introducing yourself and talking about what you do is important, at least 90% of your interaction should be about the other person not you! People tend to get carried away and talk more about their products/services in hopes of selling more which limits their networking efforts and turns people off right away. If you are meeting someone for the first time, focus all your attention on listening to them and asking questions to show your interest.
- 2. Provide value before asking for favors! Building a relationship with your connections should be your number one goal. Don't expect people you just met to go out of their way to benefit you. It's a two-way street and the sooner you start giving, the more you will receive later. Show your connections that you are interested in their success, not just focused on yours.
- 3. Many people get into the habit of spending the majority of their time with someone they know and like, but that defeats the purpose of attending a networking event! Your goal is to expand your network by building new connections. Manage your time strategically to allow you to meet new people and reconnect with old ones.
- 4. Attend more than one type of event and make networking a regular activity! Don't pick one type of event and stick to it. Take advantage of the different

benefits you can get from the various types of events. Smaller, casual networking events provide more intimacy and give you a chance to connect on a deeper level. Bigger, annual events can generate a lot of exposure to your business and present you to the community as a leader in your field.

5. Save contact information on your phone and don't just rely on keeping business cards. Business cards are very easy to lose or misplace. It is a good idea to get into the practice of saving contact information on your phone as soon as you leave the event.

Police Department Launching a New Notification System




This spring, the Roselle Police Department is rolling a new opt-in community notification system. The department is partnering with Nixle to implement its Community Notification System to alert residents in real-time for localized emergency situations and relevant community advisories, like severe weather, criminal activities, traffic

incidents, missing events, local events, and more.

Residents can register by texting 60172 to 888777 from their mobile phones or online at www.roselle.il.us/Police. Once registered, residents will receive a confirmation text to their mobile device. Residents may also customize their alert settings by going to the Nixle website at www.nixle.com and creating a user profile. The service is secure, reliable and easy to use.

All alerts will be targeted geographically, allowing residents to receive localized, relevant alerts from the Roselle Police Department. Nixle Alerts can be sent via text, email, web, and the Nixle Mobile App in an instant. Nixle is partnered with NLETS for unmatched data security, as well as the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children, the National Blue Alert Network, and Google for unmatched reach and two-way information exchange.
