### **APPLICANT CRITERIA**

Student applicants must meet the following minimum criteria:

- The applicant must be a resident of Roselle **or** the son/daughter of a Roselle Chamber of Commerce & Industry member-in-good-standing.
- The applicant must be a High School graduating Senior entering vocational school, business school, college, or university in the Fall semester of 2024.
- The applicant must have demonstrated ability to achieve academic success by maintaining at least a C average throughout his or her High School career.

The scholarship committee will use the following unranked criteria to award the scholarship:

- The applicant will demonstrate past academic ability.
- The applicant will exhibit leadership qualities among their peers.
- The applicant will display community involvement in and out of high school.
- The applicant will show the ability to communicate in writing his or her intentions to return to a community the benefits they have received from continued education.
